### **Project Sunday**

**Sunday, October 19, 2008**

Join us for fashion-focused films during the run of the exhibition. The first film, *Unzipped*, is a documentary about Isaac Mizrahi and his quest to seek inspiration after reading mixed reviews of his 1993 show. There will be a discussion following the film. This program is FREE with Museum admission and begins at 1:30 p.m.

### **In the K/Now**

In the K/Now is a monthly series which explores contemporary issues affecting Chicagoans. *The Politics of Fashion* will explore the growing relationship between political movements, ethics, and the clothes worn everyday through this panel discussion.
